Rules of Entry

1. You must live within the Parish of Camelford (this covers Trewalder, Newhall Green, Valley Truckle, Tregoodwell, Helstone, Slaughterbridge, Treforda, Lanteglos) OR attend Camelford Primary School or Sir James Smith's School. We reserve the right to check this information.
2. You must be aged between 10 and 18.
3. Your song/music must be your own! Covers are acceptable, but you must be the one performing the music that you upload.
4. Only 1 song to be uploaded onto Soundcloud.com.
5. Sufficient details must be emailed to admin@camelford-tc.gov.uk in order to find your music. We will not be held responsible for any music uploaded which we were unable to find. All efforts will be made to ensure this is unlikely to happen. We require the song name and your band/name that you use on Soundcloud.com.
6. All prizes are non-transferrable. They will be issued to one person only. If you are in a band, it is a good idea to nominate someone to take the prize who will share with other musicians involved.
7. You must be available to play at Music in the Park on 2 June and be available between 3.30pm and 5.30pm. You must ensure you have all your musical instruments. Only a PA system and mics will be provided.
8. No reading off phones or tablets during the performance. You must learn your words!
9. We are not responsible for any costs you may incur in producing your music or hire of any equipment you may need.
10. You give permission for Camelford Town Council to take images (still and video) for marketing purposes. These will be published on our website, social media and local press.
11. If there are opportunities to be interviewed for television or radio, you agree to take part.
