

Q1 Do you pay Council Tax to Camelford Town Council? (please tick one)











Q7 Should the Council install 2 ticket machines to enforce parking restrictions





Q8 Should an extra ticket machine be installed by the library in order to enforce the 9 disabled and short-term parking bays in that area? (Please tick just one)








