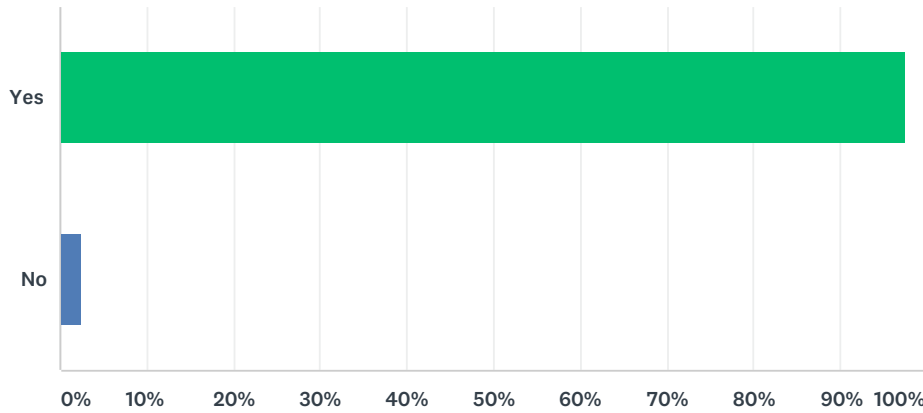


# Q1 Do you pay Council Tax to Camelford Town Council? (please tick one)

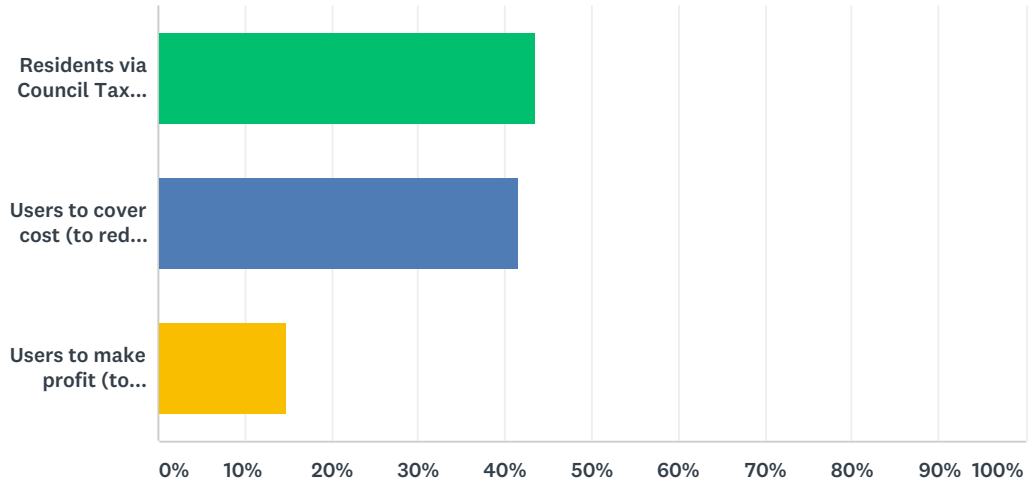

## Q2 Should the car park be funded by: (please tick just one)

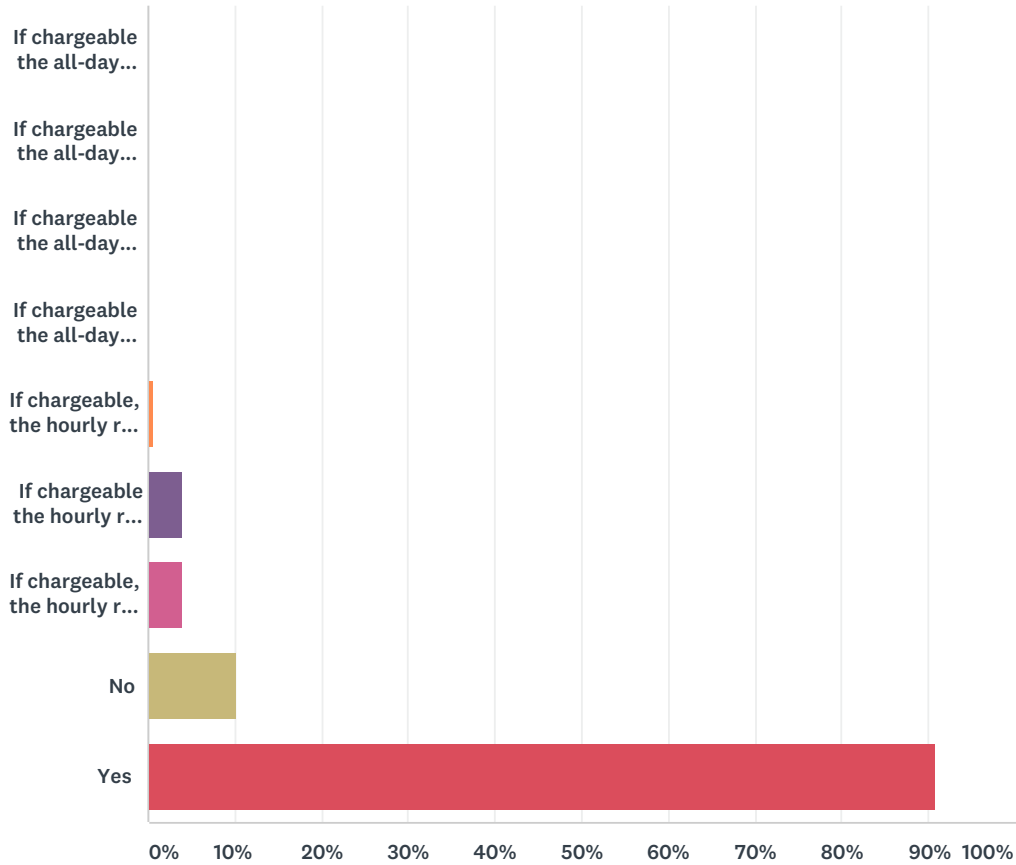

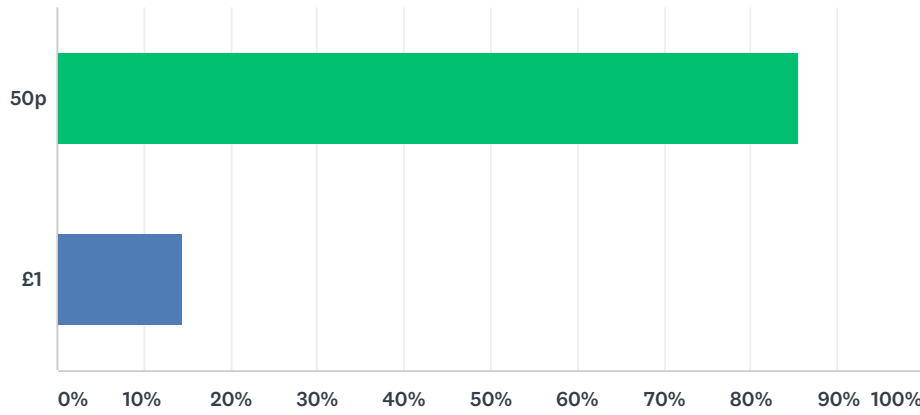

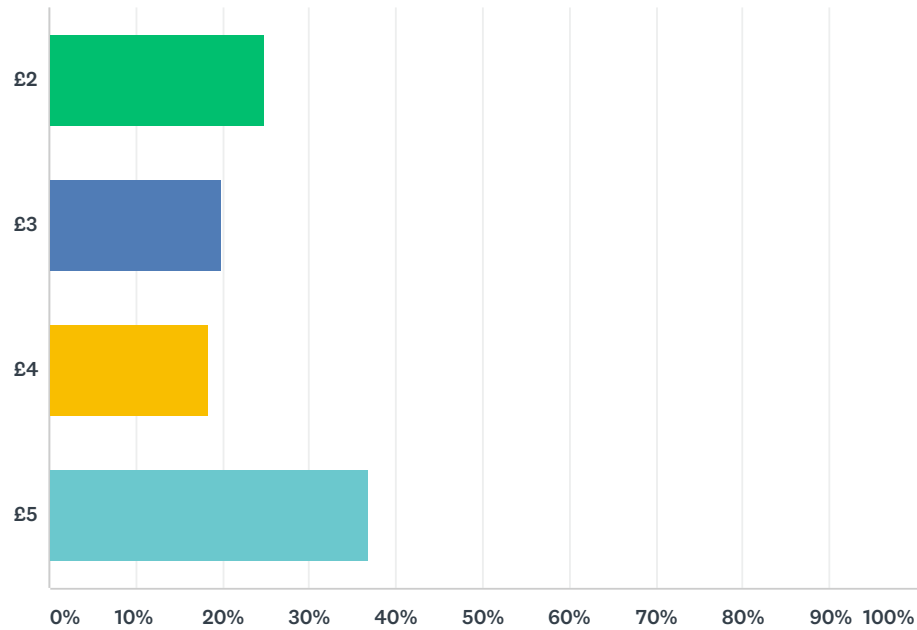

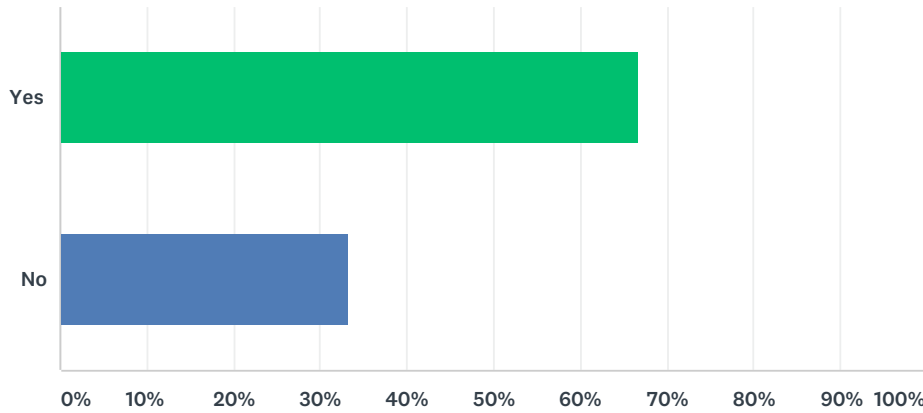

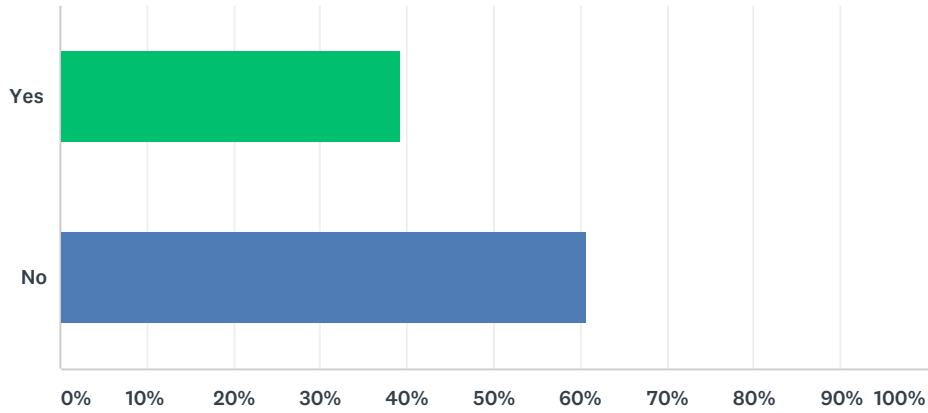

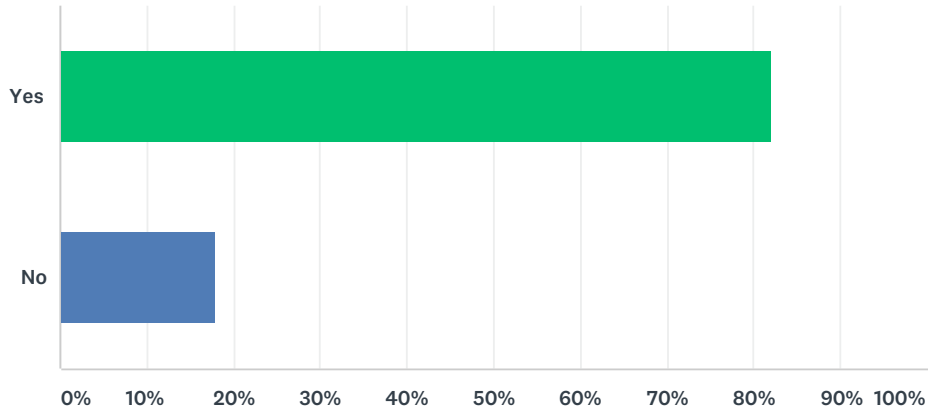

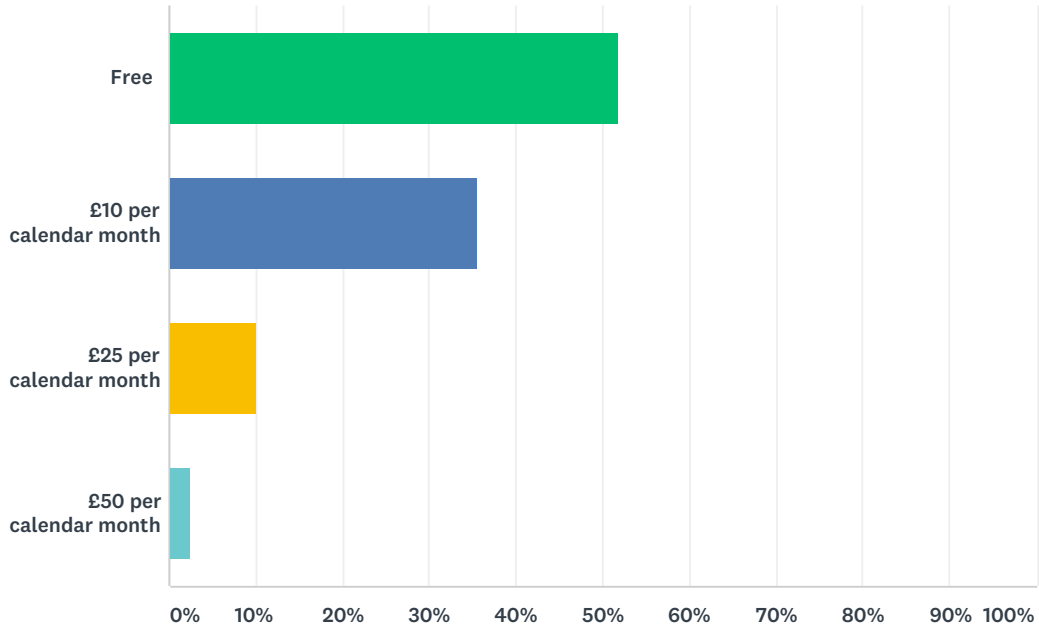

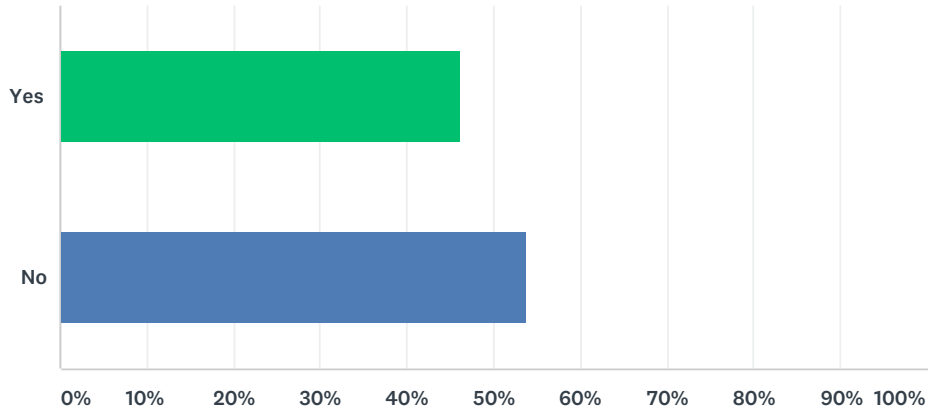

**Q11 Should the Council enter into negotiations with Cornwall Council regarding taking on the ownership/responsibility for Clease Road car park? (Please tick just one)**

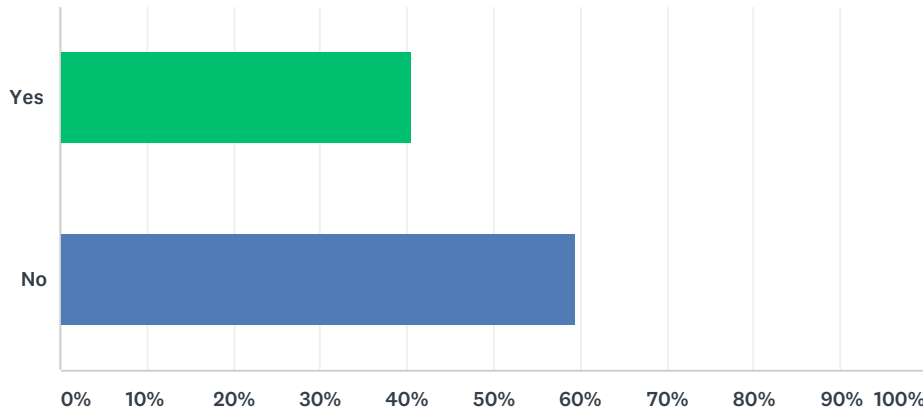
