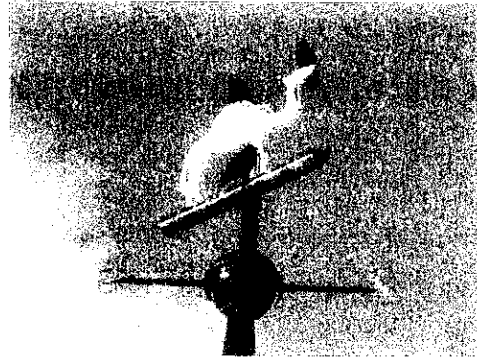


CAMELFORD QUESTIONNAIRE
