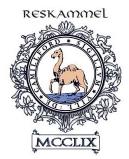

1. Clerk's report

Wallgate in Men's Public Toilet will be installed this week. Churchfield car park interceptor has been emptied. Pocket Parks grant application was rejected. Cemetery is open – local funeral directors have been informed; page has been added to CTC website. Radon testing kit has been sent back. £10k was moved from savings account to current account to cover end of year period and has been moved back. Lime Tree at Tregoodwell – CC will do a climbing inspection at its first opportunity following lock-down; but it will not take responsibility for it now or in the future. Accounting end of year has been completed. Broadwood Path steps have been replaced. Requests for help during self-isolation have been forwarded to Volunteer Cornwall. Have volunteered CTC admin support for the CC local community hub (see CALC FAQ 7C Any Cllrs interested in volunteering?). If CTC is to hold virtual meeting then it also has to be accessible to the public (see CALC FAQ 7B) – continuing to look for best option for this – have asked Yetiserve for advice. There is no statutory duty for CTC to call an annual parish meeting of electors. Office staff are working from home were possible but collecting work from Town Hall on alternative days to avoid contact. Grounds staff are working on alternative days where possible; mainly ensuring cemetery is ready and ensuring public health by continuing to litter pick/change bins. Enfield park will require sporadic essential maintenance during which time the park or sections will be temporarily closed to the public to ensure social distancing.

B. Consultation Items

- a. Whether to pay grant application for £1,000 to the Parish of Lanteglos-by-Camelford for grass cutting and hedge maintenance (budgeted expenditure).
- b. Whether to enter into 3-year green electricity contract with SSE for Enfield park. Renewal comes due with British Gas 23rd April it does not provide a green electricity tariff. SSE are the cheapest of the quotes provided by broker. Approx total cost of £1654.23 over the 3 year period.
- c. Whether to renew maintenance agreement with Jackson Lifts for 2020-21 £1201 + VAT.
- d. Following CC's decision to remove recycling banks from Churchfield car park... Whether to provide recycling banks at Churchfield car park at CTC cost of approx £500pcm haulage + £50 per tonne paper/£40 cardboard. To get rid of fly tipping from that area charged to CTC at £25 per item, then additional fee for tyres £15, £22 mattresses, £15 electrical items, £58 fridges. +VAT. Clerk notes that this expenditure has not been budgeted for and could cost CTC over £10k per year. CC notes in its explanation of removal of the service that all households have a doorstop recycling service now and that these areas can end up as dumping ground for commercial waste.
- e. Whether to enter into one-year contract with Biffa for commercial waste removal at Enfield Park £1275 + VAT, OCM £600 + VAT. This includes provision of waste bins. Represents best value. CC contract with Biffa for Enfield Park has finished, but continues to cover High Street/Market Place/A39
